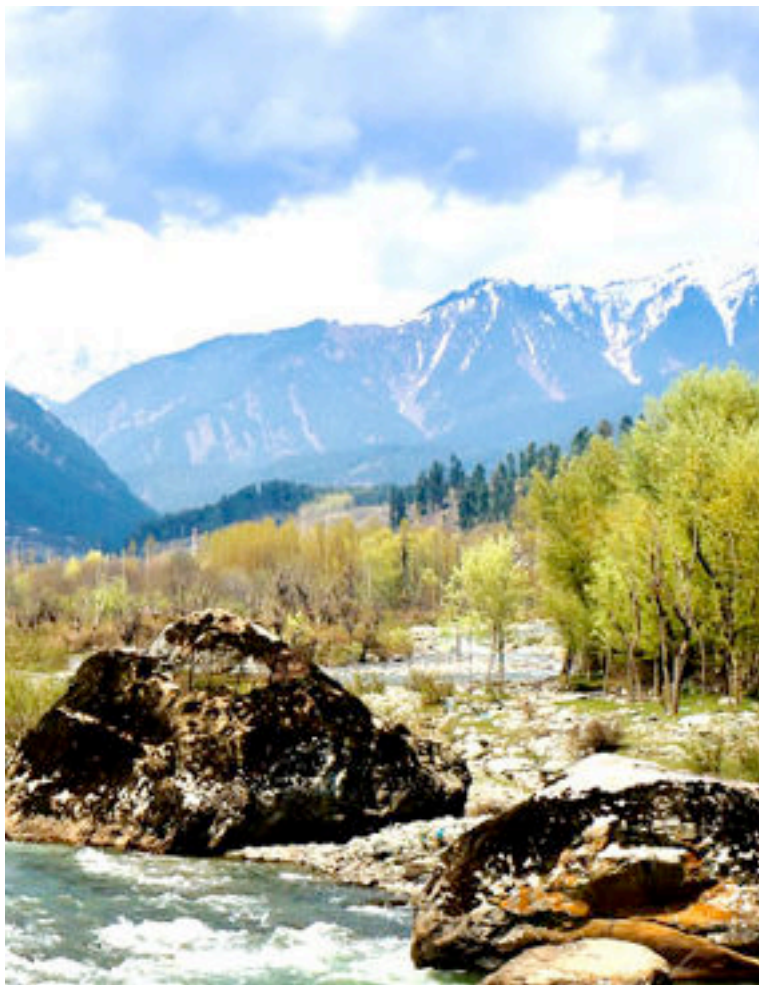


Pahalgam (7200 ft.)

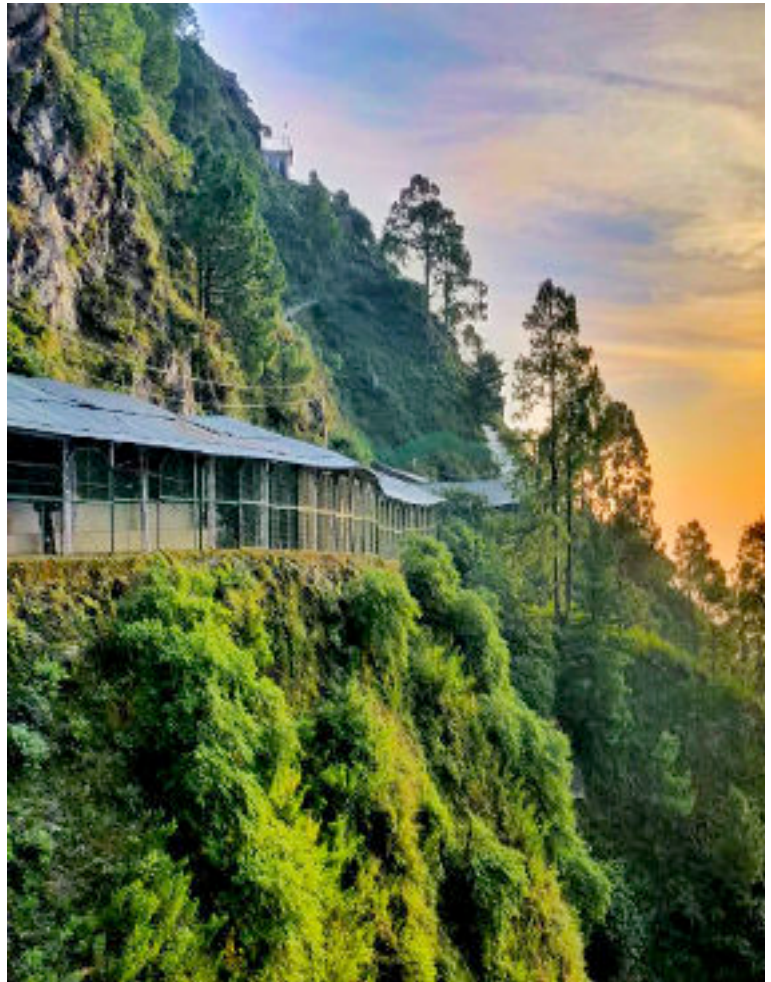

Katra

You can also enjoy shopping during your holidays in Katra, which is an exciting & unique experience because many of the things that are found here in its bustling markets, like Kashmiri motifs, cane baskets & stoles, are found exclusively in this region.



Khilanmarg

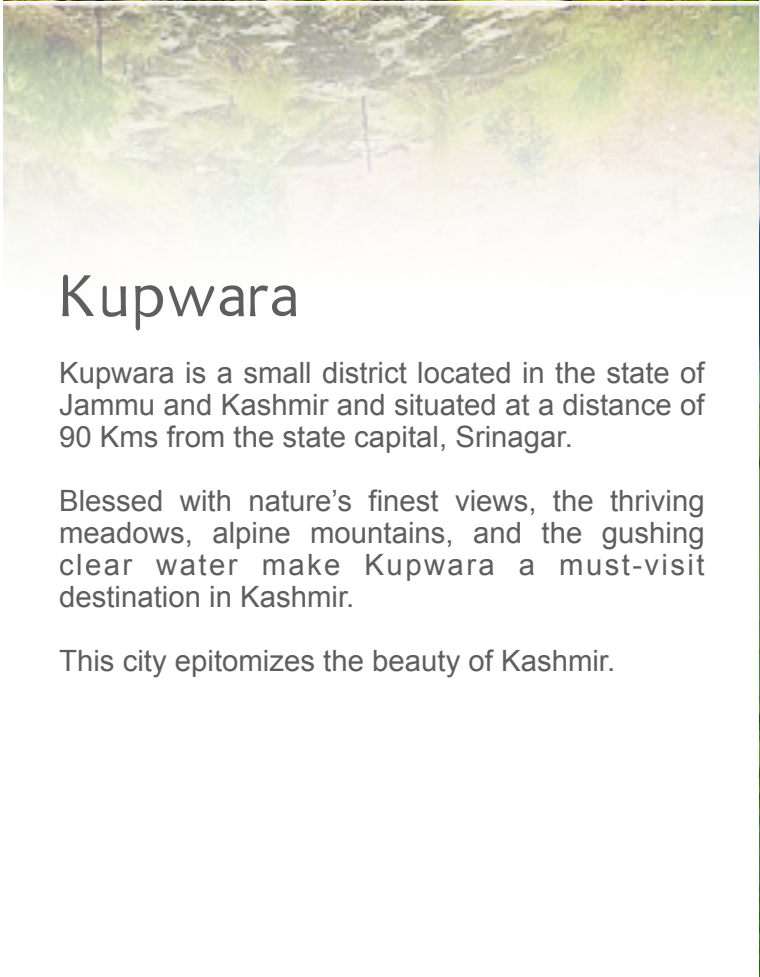

Blessed with nature’s finest views, the thriving meadows, alpine mountains, and the gushing clear water make Kupwara a must-visit destination in Kashmir.

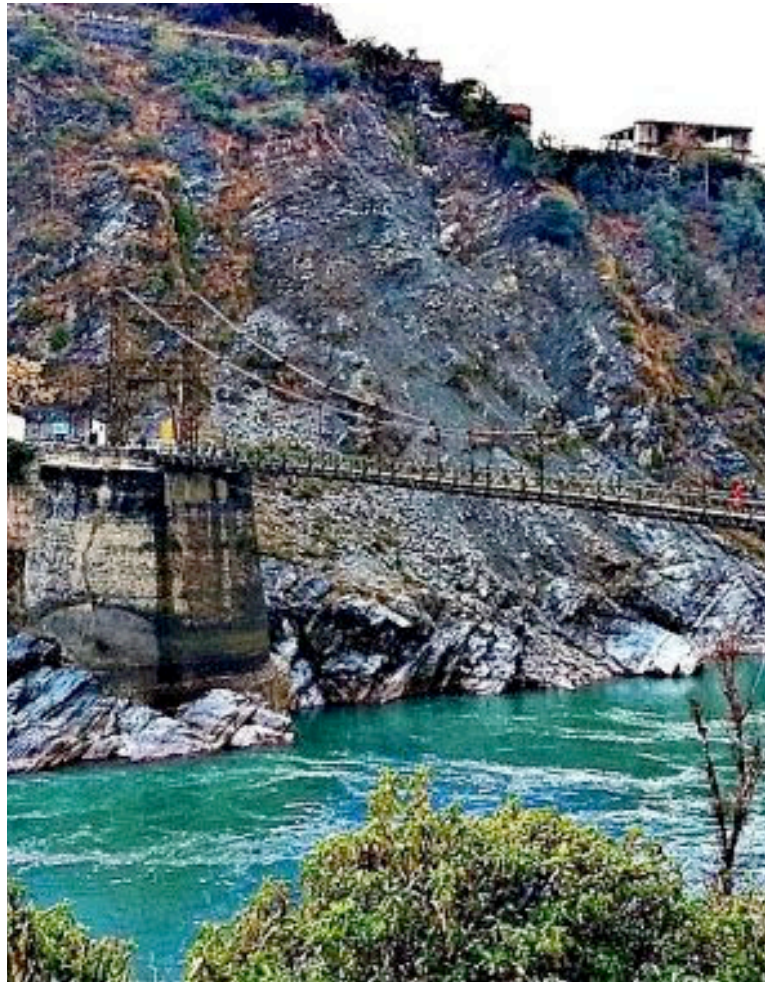
This city epitomizes the beauty of Kashmir.

Along with the houseboats, it is also considered to be a cultural symbol. But even apart from leisure and tourism purposes, the shikhara is also used by the locals for seaweed harvesting, fishing and transportation.

To watch these beautifully decorated boats glide serenely on the lake is a treat to the eyes, and you should definitely not miss out on this experience during your holidays in Jammu and Kashmir.

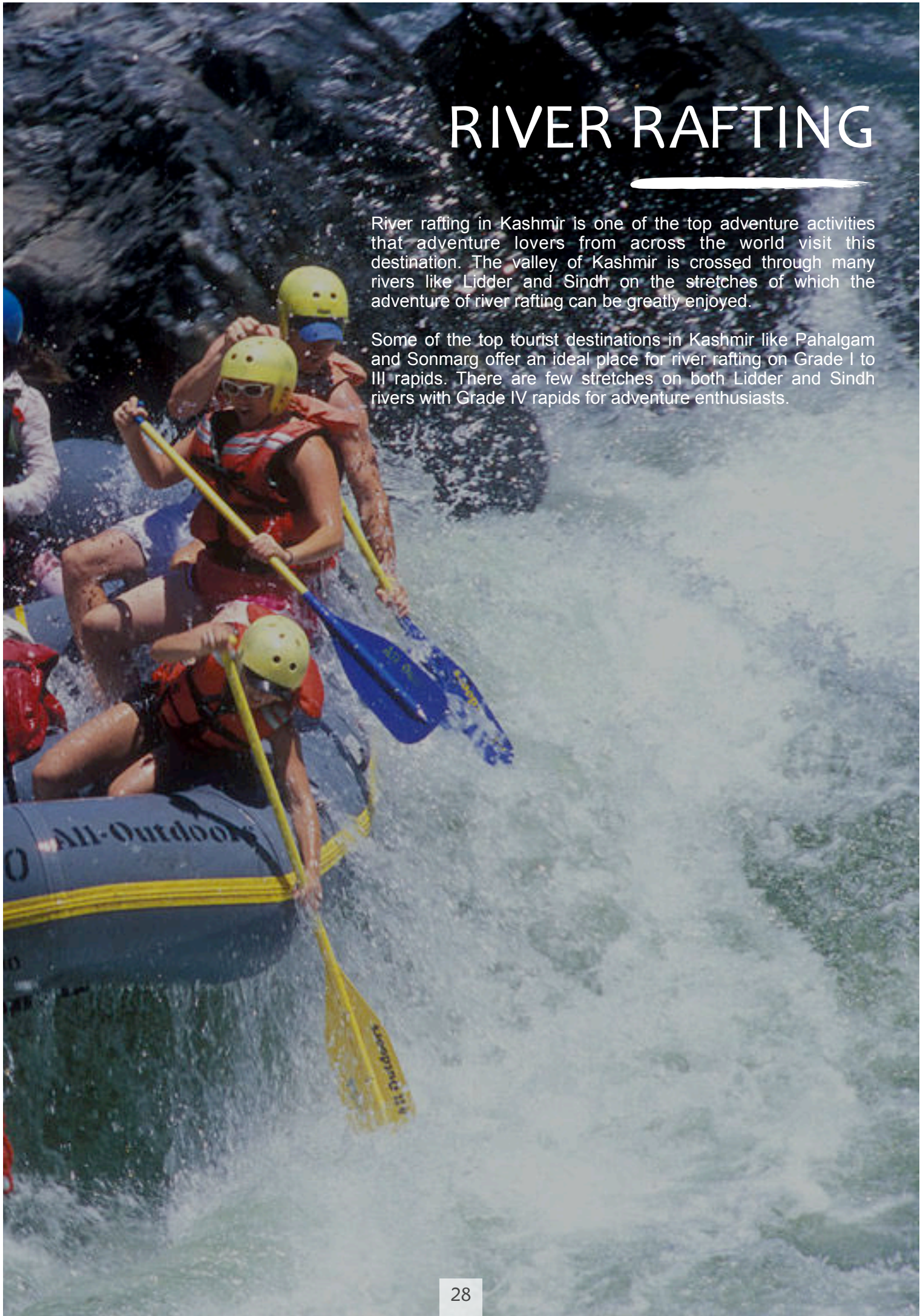
This region is a haven for bird lovers, as almost 554 species of birds reside here, apart from 262 species from the alpine regions of the Kashmir Valley.



RIVER RAFTING

River rafting in Kashmir is one of the top adventure activities that adventure lovers from across the world visit this destination. The valley of Kashmir is crossed through many rivers like Lidder and Sindh on the stretches of which the adventure of river rafting can be greatly enjoyed.

Some of the top tourist destinations in Kashmir like Pahalgam and Sonmarg offer an ideal place for river rafting on Grade I to III rapids. There are few stretches on both Lidder and Sindh rivers with Grade IV rapids for adventure enthusiasts.



GULMARG GONDOLA

Asia's largest and highest and world's second-largest and second highest cable car project, Gulmarg Gondola is the top attraction in Gulmarg. In fact, a Gulmarg tour without a ride on the popular cable car is considered incomplete.

This must-do activity in Gulmarg is perfect for family vacationers, romantic couples as well as adventurers seeking to get to the top the mountain for the best skiing experience (in winter). The scenic views of mountains and valley during the cable car ride are also unforgettable and unmatched.

The gondola can ferry 6 people at a time and 600 people per hour.

CUISINES

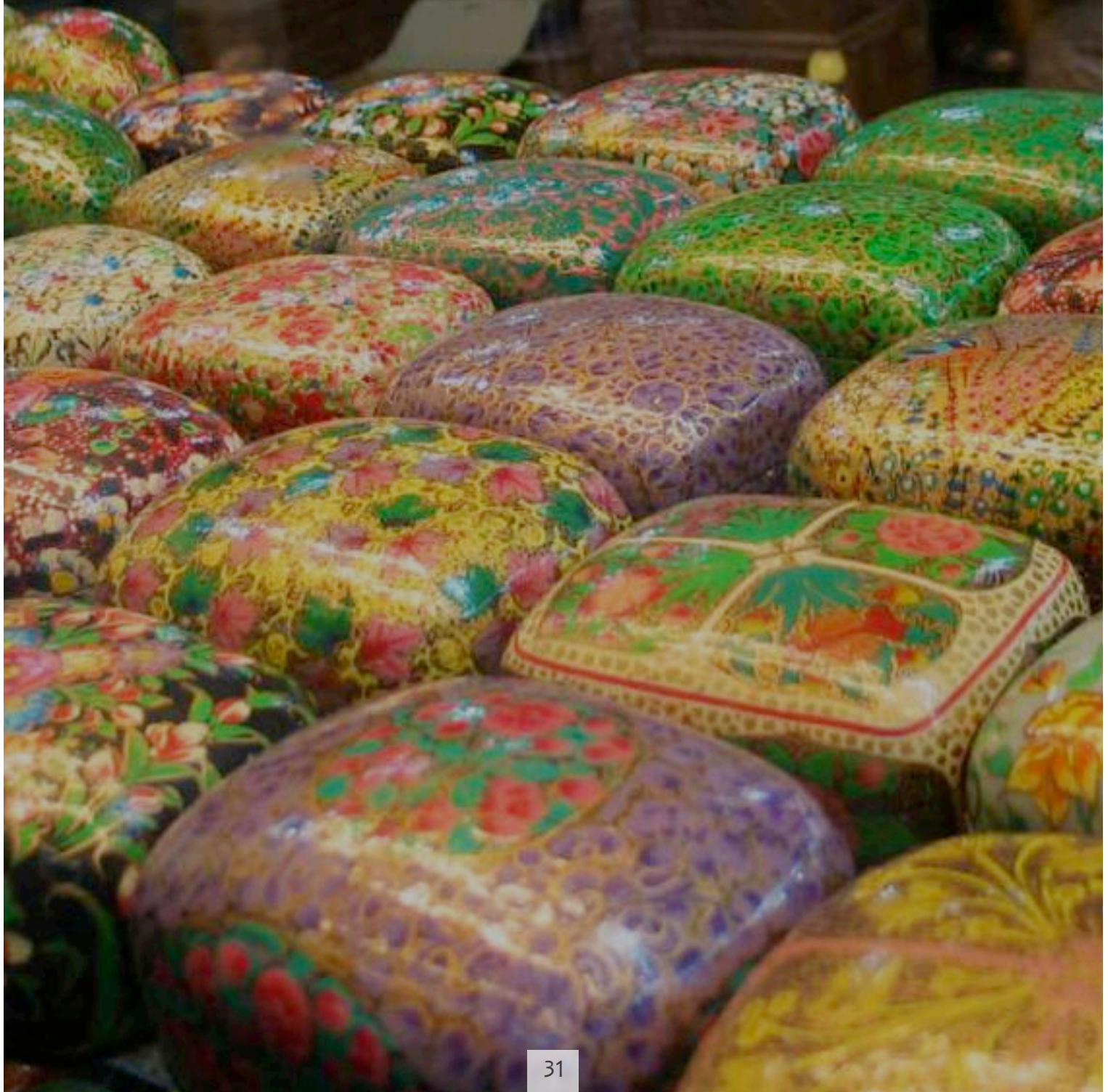
Jammu & Kashmir boasts being flavoursome and diverse. The union territory with its variety of dishes makes an excellent destination for culinary tourism and attracts food lovers from around the world. The food of Jammu & Kashmir can be divided into two- Jammu Cuisine and Kashmiri Cuisine; each of which is unique in their own way.

The Kashmiri food is further categorized into two - Kashmiri Pandits/Brahmins Cuisine and Kashmiri Muslim Cuisines. While the Pandits use generous quantities of curd along with asafoetida and ginger in their food, Muslims use all these ingredients in liberal amounts for food preparations along with ginger and garlic. However, one can find some commonality between the cuisine of Jammu and Kashmir regions.

SHOPPING

Shopping in Jammu and Kashmir can be a very enriching and exciting experience. 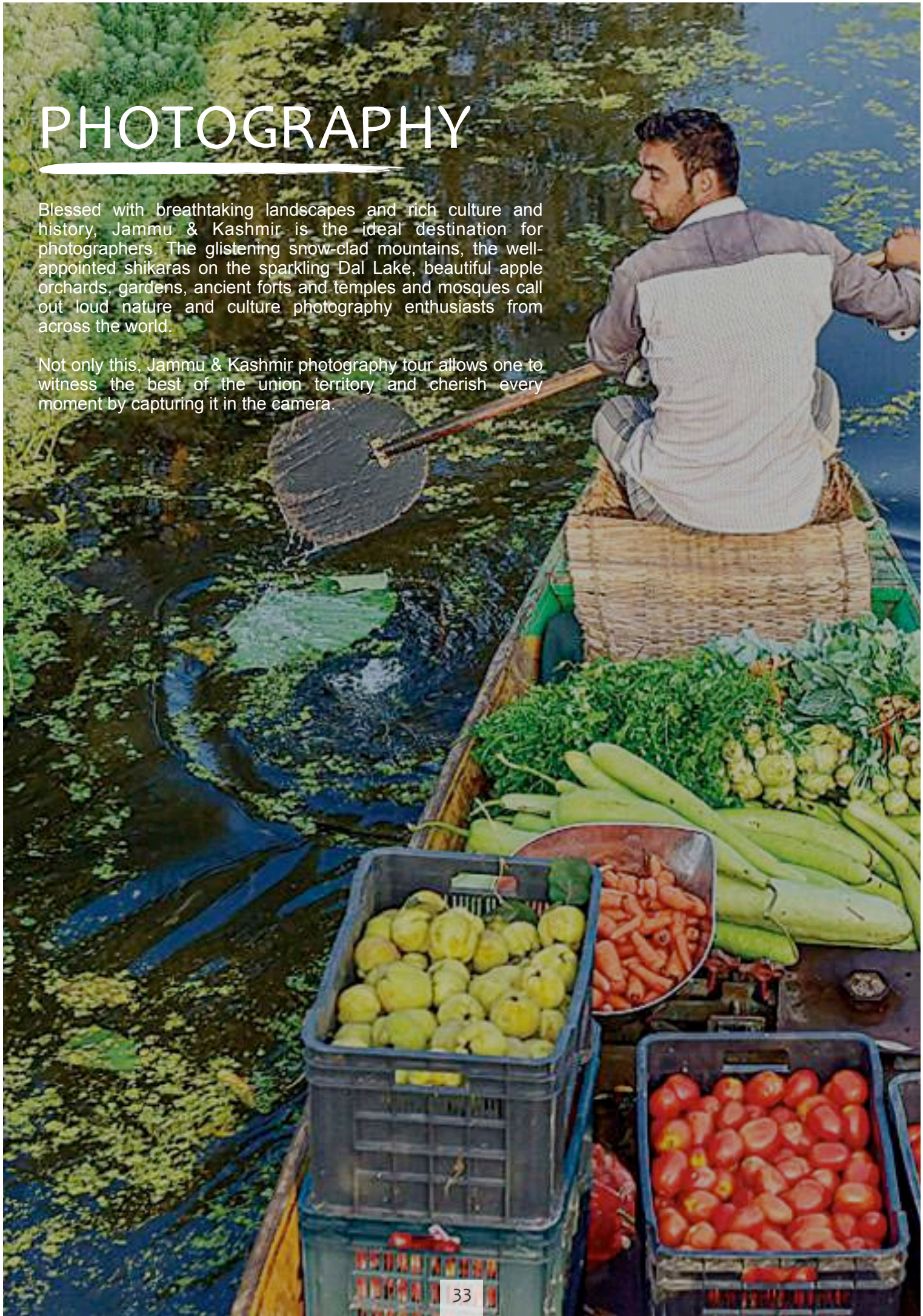
Apart from relishing the stunning vistas of these some azure and some emerald lakes, one can enjoy many activities in and around them like shikara ride, trout fishing and even camping.

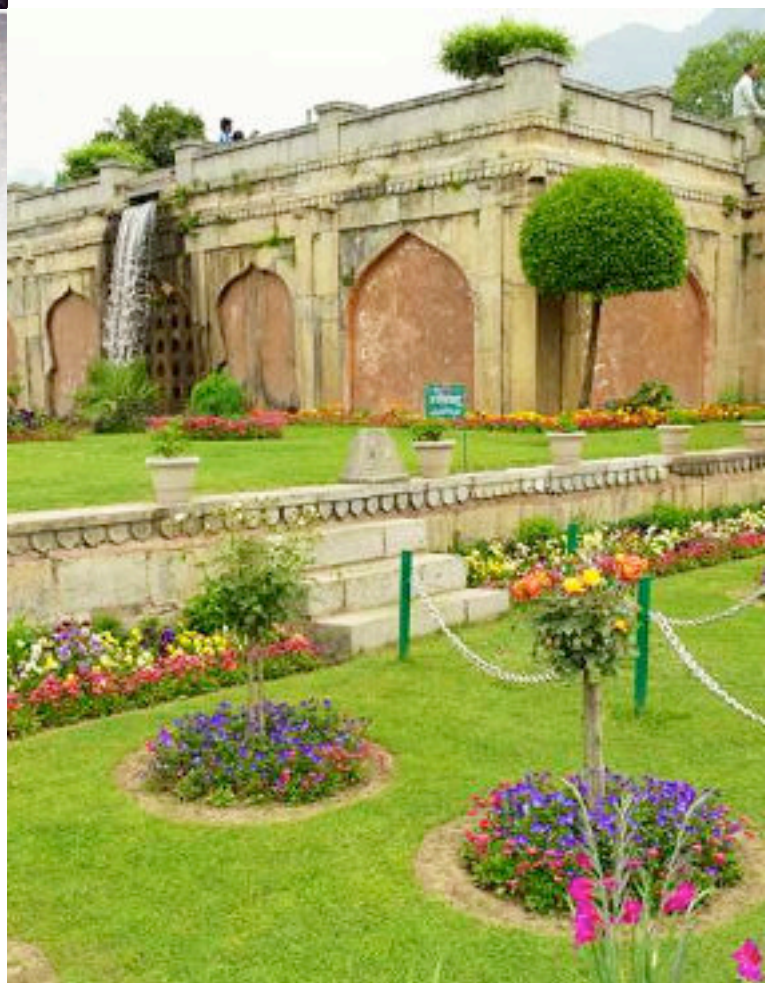
The seven lakes of Girgan Dhok have to be in your itinerary, alongside many religious shrines like Baksh Sahib and Gurudwara Nangali Sahib.

Jama Masjid

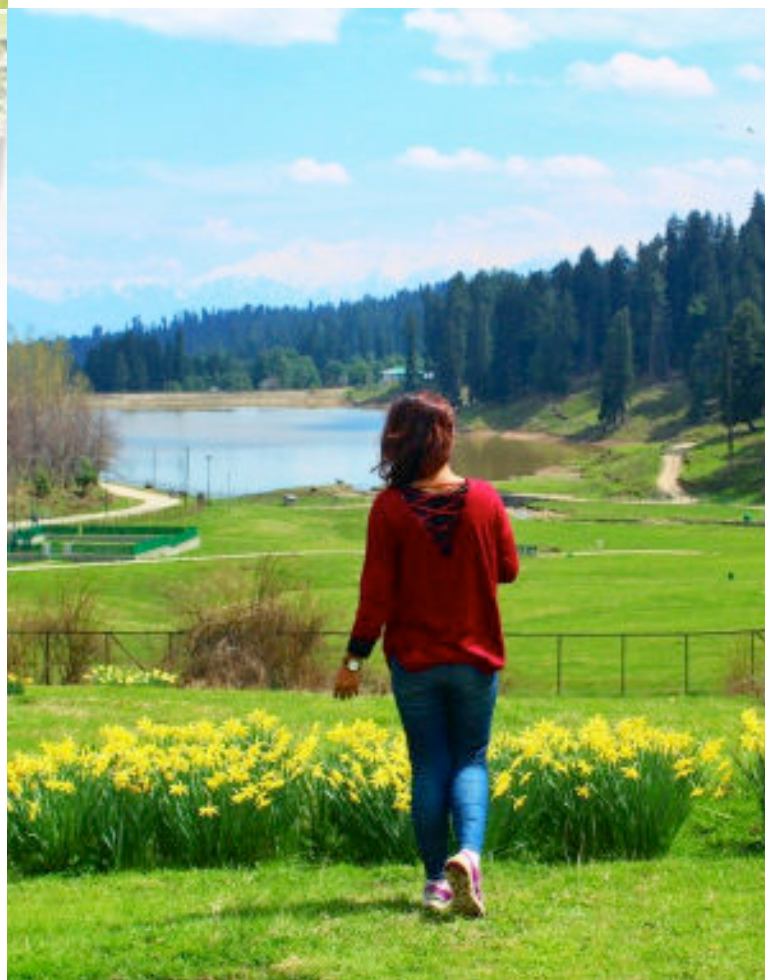

This is considered to be the best place when it comes to observing the natural aspects of Kashmir. This is one of the top tourist places in Kashmir that is not much explored.

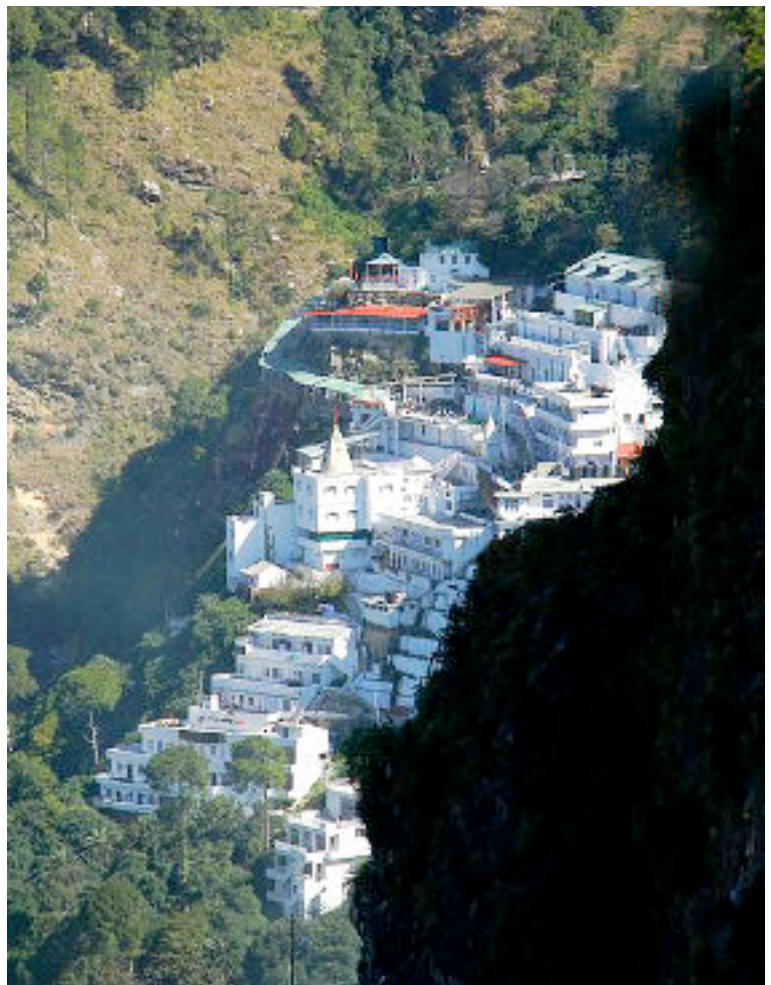

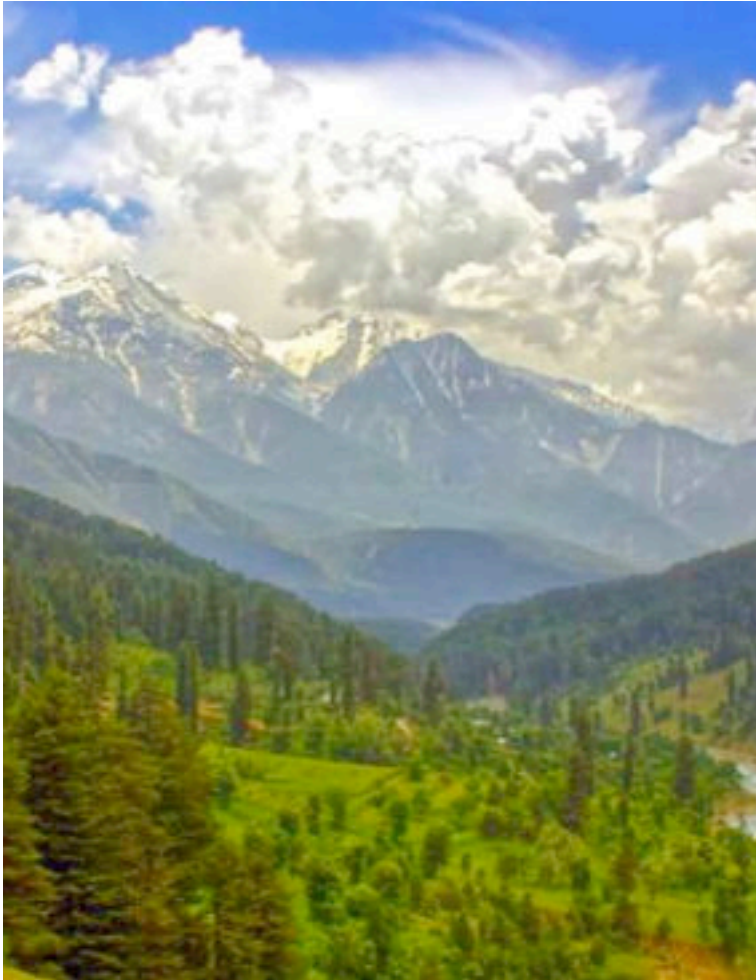

Amarnath

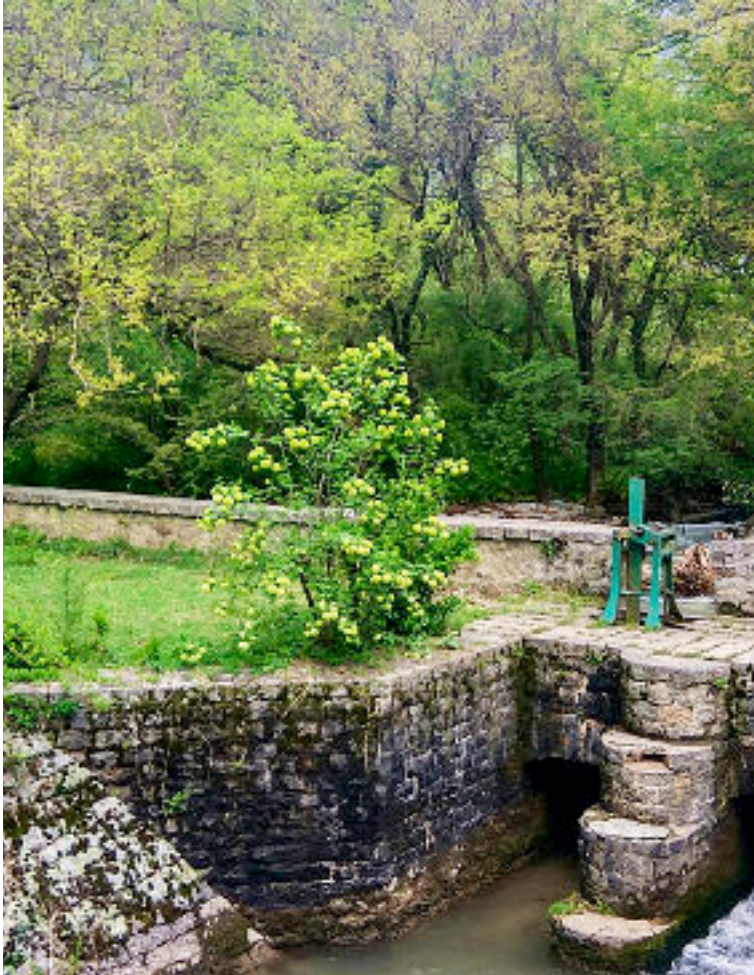

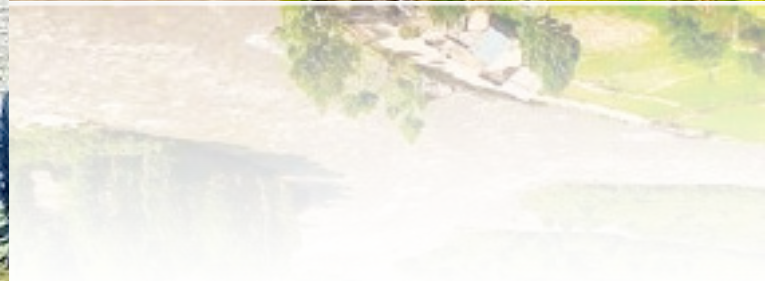
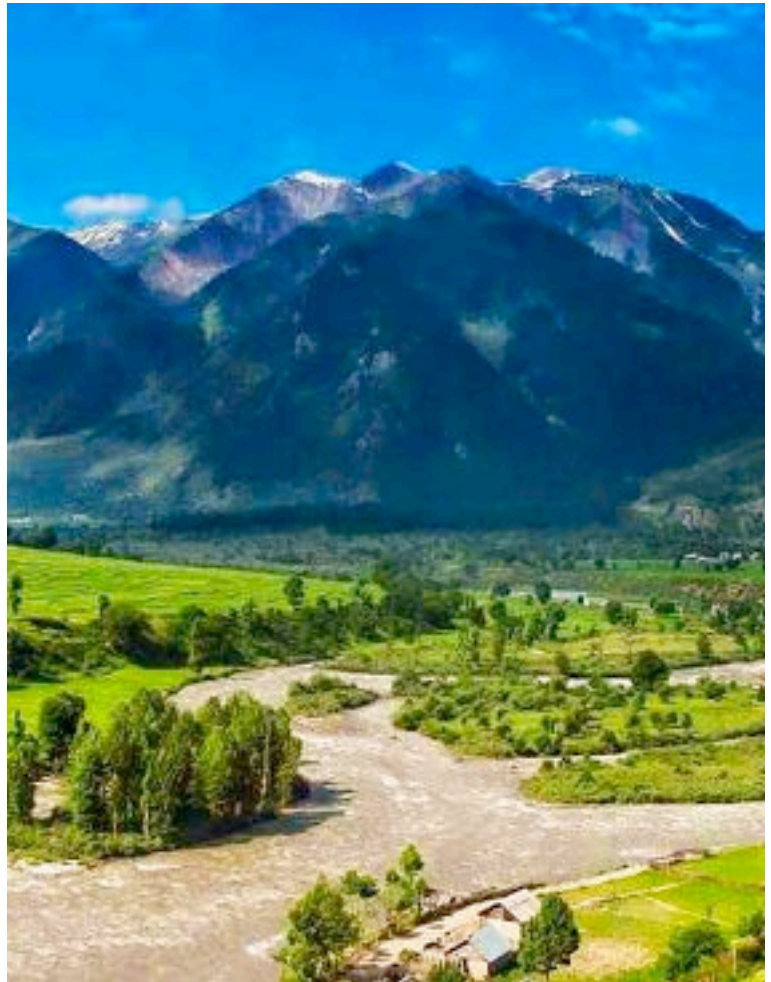
Bhaderwah

Kishtwar National Park

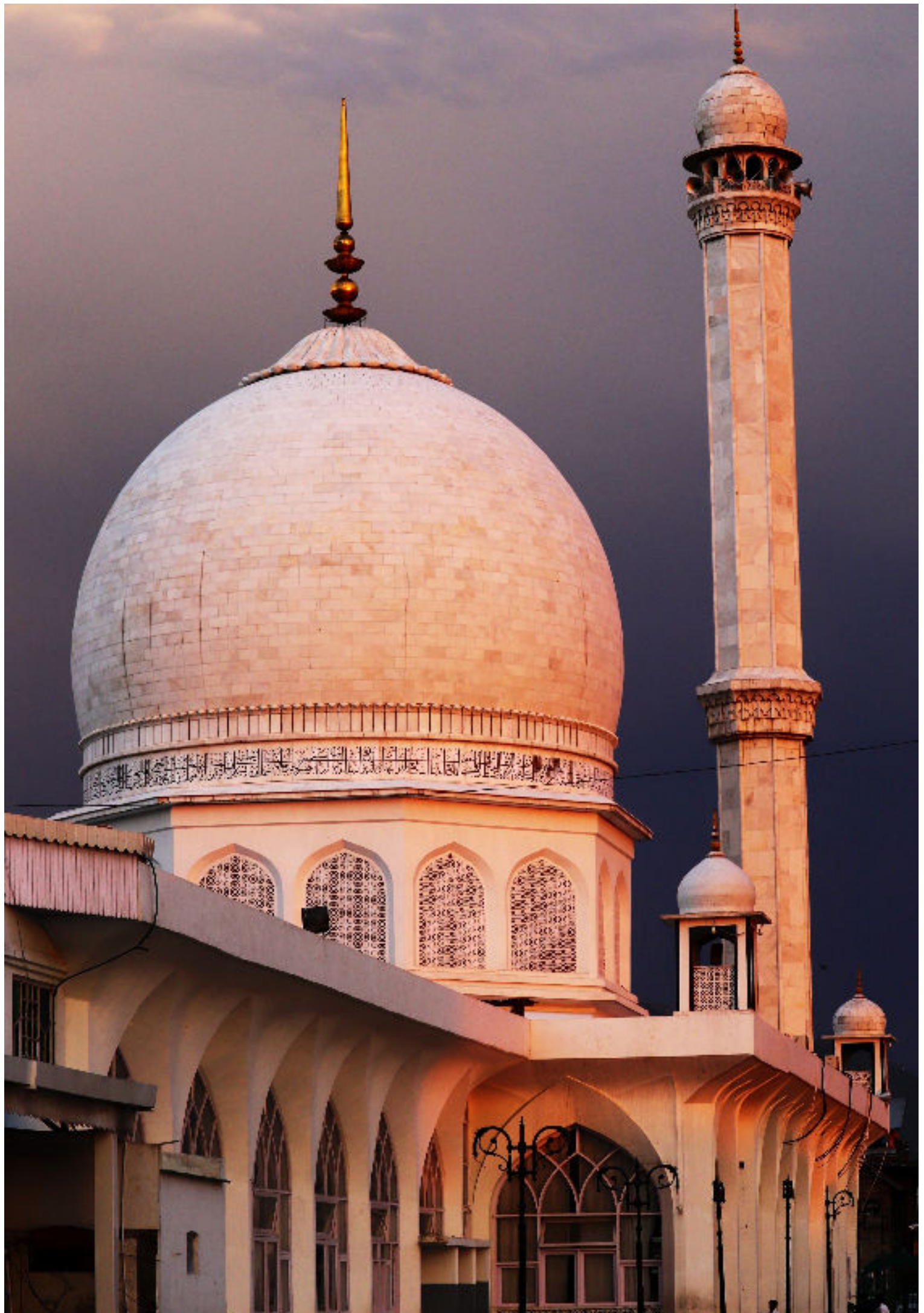
